DECLARATION OF RICHARD SELTZER

I, Richard Seltzer, declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. My name is Richard Seltzer, and I am a Political Science professor at Howard University, where I currently teach graduate courses in statistics and research methods. For the past thirty-three years, I have also designed and conducted various surveys. Additionally, I have authored numerous publications, which are listed in the attached curriculum vitae. On account of my experience in the field, I have previously been qualified as an expert in statistics and survey research in several federal and state courts. In addition to my teaching responsibilities, I have acted as a consultant to a variety of organizations in creating and maintaining complex databases. For the last sixteen years, I have worked with the Alliance of Artists and Recording Companies ("AARC") as a royalty distribution system and sales data consultant. It is through this professional relationship that I have become familiar with Nielsen SoundScan's sales data,¹ the data my following testimony is based upon.

2. I confirm that AARC's Royalty Distribution System uses SoundScan data to determine the annual allocation of the DART Sound Recordings Fund royalties among claimants before the Copyright Royalty Board.

3. I have reviewed the 2013 SoundScan record sales data in the AARC Royalty Distribution System based on featured recording artists and found as follows:

- a. I searched the name George Clinton, P-Funk Allstars, The Parliaments, Parliament, Parlet, Funkadelic, and Brides of Funkenstein and I searched for the title listed in Mr. Clinton's featured recording artist claim (see attachment to my declaration). I found 74,243.86 record sales for Mr. Clinton.
- b. I searched the name Ronald Ford and I searched for the titles listed in Mr. Ford's featured recording artist claim (see attachment to my declaration). I found 2,026 record sales for Mr. Ford.
- c. I searched the name David C. Powell, Jr., David Powell, and David C. Powell and I searched for the title listed in Mr. Powell's featured recording artist claim (see attachment to my declaration). I found no record sales for David C. Powell, Jr.

4. I have reviewed the 2013 SoundScan record sales data in the AARC Royalty Distribution System based on copyright owners and found as follows:

a. I searched the name George Clinton, P-Funk Allstars, The Parliaments, Parliament, Parlet, Funkadelic, and Brides of Funkenstein and I searched for the title listed in Mr. Clinton's copyright owner claim (see attachment to my declaration) and found 9,253

record sales for the title. SoundScan data identified Warner Music Group not George Clinton as the sound recording copyright owner.

- b. I searched the name Herman Kelly and I searched for the titles listed in Mr. Kelly's copyright owner claim (see attachment to my declaration) and found 1,505 record sales for Herman Kelly.
- c. I searched the name Kami Talpa and I searched for the titles listed in Ms. Talpa's copyright owner claim (see attachment to my declaration) and found 68 record sales for Kami Talpa.
- d. I searched the name David C. Powell, Jr. David Powell, and David C. Powell and I searched for the title listed in Mr. Powell's copyright owner claim (see attachment to my declaration) and found no record sales for David C. Powell, Jr.
- e. I searched the name Eugene Curry and I searched for the title listed in Mr. Curry's copyright owner claim (see attachment to my declaration) and found 5,867 record sales for the title. SoundScan identified MCA/Universal Music Group not Eugene Curry as the sound recording copyright owner.

5. The 2013 universe of record sales for claimants to the 2013 Featured Recording Artists Subfund, which includes record sales of the Settling Parties as defined in AARC's "Notice of Settlement and Request for Partial Distribution of the 2013 DART Sound Recordings Fund Featured Recording Artists and Copyright Owners Subfunds Royalties", 74,243.86 record sales for George Clinton, 2,026 record sales for Ronald Ford, and no record sales for David C. Powell, Jr., is 1,082,137,905 record sales.

6. The 2013 universe of record sales for claimants to the 2013 Copyright Owners Subfund, which includes record sales of the Settling Parties as defined in AARC's "Notice of Settlement and Request for Partial Distribution of the 2013 DART Sound Recordings Fund Featured Recording Artists and Copyright Owners Subfunds Royalties", 9,253 record sales for George Clinton, 1,505 record sales for Herman Kelly, 5,867 record sales for Eugene Curry, 68 record sales for Kami Talpa, and no record sales for David C. Powell, Jr., is 1,163,565,099 record sales.



DECLARATION OF RICHARD SELTZER

I, Richard Seltzer, declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. My name is Richard Seltzer, and I am a Political Science professor at Howard University, where I currently teach graduate courses in statistics and research methods. For the past thirty-three years, I have also designed and conducted various surveys. Additionally, I have authored numerous publications, which are listed in the attached curriculum vitae. On account of my experience in the field, I have previously been qualified as an expert in statistics and survey research in several federal and state courts. In addition to my teaching responsibilities, I have acted as a consultant to a variety of organizations in creating and maintaining complex databases. For over eighteen years I have worked with the Alliance of Artists and Recording Companies ("AARC") as a royalty distribution system and titles' sales data consultant. It is through this professional relationship that I have become familiar with Nielsen SoundScan's titles' sales data,¹ the data my following testimony is based upon.

2. I confirm that AARC's Royalty Distribution System uses SoundScan data to determine the annual allocation of the DART Sound Recordings Fund royalties among claimants before the Copyright Royalty Board.

3. I have repeated my review of the 2013 SoundScan titles' sales data in the AARC Royalty Distribution System based on additional information provided in George Clinton's and Ronald Ford's comments of November 5, 2014 with regard to the 2013 titles' sales of Featured Recording Artists and found as follows:

- a. I searched for any sales reported for the "Funkadelic Masters" titles listed in George Clinton's comments. All of these titles, I had already identified during my research in July and so reported in my July 25, 2014 declaration.
- b. I searched for any sales reported for the titles listed in George Clinton's Exhibit A, "Selected Sampleography," if Clinton or any of his performing names were featured on the title that sampled his work and the work sampled was one of the "Funkadelic Masters" titles listed in George Clinton's comments. I found one title, "Gettin It" by Too Short, the sales for which I have now added to Clinton's total Featured Recording Artist titles' sales.
- c. Upon recalculating Clinton's sales, based on all the additional information, Clinton's total 2013 titles' sales as a Featured Recording Artist are 298,367.95.

d. I searched for any sales reported for the titles listed in the Ronald Ford Comments Exhibit A. See Exhibit 1.1, attached. I compared the list of titles I researched in July² with the list included in Ford's comments and found that I had credited him with the sales of all the titles³ but ten (10) that were listed in Ford's 2013 Sound Recordings Fund Featured Recording Artists claim. See Exhibit 1.2, 1.4(A). The total sales for these new ten (10) titles are 701 sales. See Exhibit 1.4 (A), attached. Additionally, twelve (12) of the titles originally listed in Ford's claim were not credited to him in July because they either reported a different Featured Recording Artist or they reported Ford as the writer/composer. See Exhibit 1.4(B), attached. By adding the sales for the new eight (8) titles and the twelve (12) titles that reported a different Featured Recording Artist or reported Ford as the writer/composer, I found 3,475 additional titles' sales for Ford. Therefore Ford's total 2013 titles' sales as a Featured Recording Artist are 5,501. See Exhibit 1.4, attached.

4. I have repeated my review of the 2013 SoundScan titles' sales data in the AARC Royalty Distribution System based on additional information regarding the "Funkadelic Masters" provided in footnote 7 of George Clinton's comments of November 5, 2014, with regard to the titles' sales of Copyright Owners and found as follows:

- a. I searched for any sales reported for the "Funkadelic Masters" titles listed in George Clinton's comments. One of these titles, "One Nation Under A Groove," which was listed in Clinton's 2013 Sound Recordings Fund Copyright Owners claim, I had already identified during my research in July and so reported in my July 25, 2014 declaration. I found 14,402 sales for the other "Funkadelic Masters" titles. Adding these 14,402 titles' sales to those he was credited in July, the new total titles' sales is 23,655.
- b. I searched for any sales reported for the "Selected Sampleography" titles included in the Clinton Comments Exhibit A, which sample a Funkadelic Master title. I found 74,633 additional titles' sales for nine (9) Funkadelic Masters titles. See Exhibit 2.
- c. Therefore Clinton's total 2013 titles' sales as a Copyright Owner are 112,690.
