# SPANISH LANGUAGE PRODUCERS PETITION TO PARTICIPATE IN DISTRIBUTION PROCEEDINGS

Spanish Language Producers ("SLP"), pursuant to the *Notice Announcing*Commencement of Distribution Proceedings With Request for Petitions to Participate,
published December 22, 2014 by the Copyright Royalty Board, Library of Congress, 79

Fed. Reg. 76396, hereby notifies the Copyright Office as follows:

SLP maintains claims in the yet-to-be-established Spanish language programming category. As the copyright owners and holders of programming broadcast on stations whose signals were carried on a distant signal basis during any time

2010 through 2012, SLP and the parties listed on the attachment have a significant interest in the subject matter of these proceedings.

As required by the Judge's notice, SLP has attached a check with their \$150 filing fee, payable to the Copyright Royalty Board.
