JOINT PETITION TO PARTICIPATE

On behalf of Home Shopping Network, Inc., HSN LP, Home Shopping En Espangol GP, Ingenious Designs, AST LLC, USA Broadcasting Productions, Inc., Studios USA and InterActive Corp. (formerly USA Interactive) (collectively “Joint Petitioners”), pursuant to 17 U.S.C. §§ 801(b)(3) and 804(b)(8) and 37 CFR § 351.1(b)(2), we hereby submit this Joint Petition to Participate in the Phase II distribution proceeding regarding 1999-2009 royalties collected under the satellite statutory license. Joint Petitioners have similar interests and have agreed to joint representation in this proceeding. *See* 37 CFR §351.1(b)(2)(ii).

Home Shopping Network, Inc., HSN LP, Home Shopping En Espangol GP, Ingenious Designs, AST LLC, USA Broadcasting Productions, Inc., Studios USA and InterActive Corp.

(C) In a cable or satellite royalty distribution proceeding, identification of whether the petition covers a Phase I proceeding (the initial part of a distribution proceeding where royalties are divided among the categories or groups of copyright owners), a Phase II proceeding (where the money allotted to each category is subdivided among the various copyright owners within that category), or both:

The Petition covers the Phase II satellite distribution proceeding for Program Supplier Category, years 1999-2006.

(D) A description of the participants' significant interest in the subject matter of the proceeding:

Joint Petitioners are producers, distributors and copyright owners of syndicated programming within the Program Supplier Category. They have submitted timely claims for statutory royalties from the satellite royalty fund for relevant years and, therefore, maintain a significant interest in the allocation of shares in the Program Supplier Category. Joint Petitioners understand that there are other claimants seeking a share of the Program Supplier Category allocation. While Joint Petitioners have not reached a settlement with any other potential Phase II claimant, based on discussions to date, they anticipate that such settlement is possible which could obviate the need for a hearing of any dispute involving the Joint Petitioners.

(E) If the joint petition is filed by counsel or a representative of one or more of the participants that are named in the joint petition, a statement from such counsel or representative certifying that, as of the date of submission of the joint petition, such counsel or representative has the authority and consent of the participants to represent them in the royalty distribution proceeding:
